Education or Required Experience:

- 5 years of experience operating a Crane
- Must have a NCCCO certificate
- High School Diploma or GED

Required Skills:

- Responsible for operation of crane used in lifting and flipping boats
- May need to additionally hoist other materials and equipment in a safe and efficient manner
- Perform preventative maintenance as required to ensure safe and continual service of crane
- Ensure oiling of the crane is performed as needed
- Responsible for ensuring all slings and straps necessary for crane operation are ready to be used in lifting operations
- Ensure that all lifts are within load limits of crane and correctly rigged
- Ensure that crane is inspected prior to use
- Responsible for compliance with Metal Shark's safety policy and guidelines
- When not operating the crane, employee will work under the maintenance department:
 - Troubleshoots equipment problems and report problems to Facility Manager
 - Assembles new equipment and furniture
 - Clean and maintains Company Vehicles, Tractors, Forklifts, Air Compressors, and other equipment as needed
 - Performs other duties as required to maintain Metal Shark's buildings, equipment and grounds in clean, orderly, and working condition

Physical Requirements: Must be able to lift up to 50lbs. Must be able to stand, bend, stoop, squat, or kneel regularly, as well as climb stairs and ladders to complete tasks.
