Education or Required Experience:

3 to 5 years of experience in the ship/boat building industry welding aluminum

- Must be able to read blue prints
- Must be able to tack, distribute heat evenly with a clean weld
- Must be able to pass the MSB Pre-Employment Mock Weld Test

Required Skills:

- Possess strong attention to detail in order to aid Metal Shark's strong quality assurance program
- Excellent math skills with the ability to read a tape measure accurately
- Must be able to weld aluminum proficiently
- Ability to fix a defected weld
- Must be able to weld in any position (uphill, overhead, horizontal, pipe or flat)
- Ability to operate power equipment safely and comply with all safety standards
- Demonstrates strong work ethic, good communication skills, and works well with others
- Must be able to pass 3G-4G structure plate test that requires bend test for results
- To qualify for seam welder pay, you must be able to pass an seam plate test in the 3G-4G position
- To qualify for top seam welder, you must pass MSB 3G-4G groove test that requires passing a bend test free
 from stress fractures and any cracks. Also must pass MSB 1G-2mm plate test as per Metal Shark WPS and MSB
 3G and 4G-4mm plate test as per Metal Shark WPS free from stress fractures and any cracks
- To keep seam welder pay/top welder pay, you must provide quality welds consistently from day to day

Physical Requirements: Must be able to lift up to 50lbs. Must be able to stand, bend, stoop, squat or kneel regularly, as well as climb stairs and ladders to complete tasks.
